| | 22 | 1. I am over the age of 18 years and I am competent to make this declaration. I have | |
| | 23 | personal knowledge of the facts set forth herein, except for those facts stated on information and | |

| | 26 | 2. I am the appointed Chapter 7 Trustee in the above-captioned bankruptcy case. | |
| | 27 | 3. I make this declaration in support of the Ex Parte Application to (1) Employ | |
| | 28 | Assured Document Destruction, Inc. for the Destruction of Confidential Documents and Hard | |

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Drives Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 105(a) and (2) Pay Assured Document Destruction, Inc. an Amount Not to Exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) (the "Application").¹

- On January 9, 2015, Ameri-Dream Realty LLC. (the "Debtor") filed a voluntary 4. bankruptcy pursuant to Chapter 7 of Title 11 of the United States Code [ECF No. 1]².
- On January 9, 2015, I was appointed as the Chapter 7 Trustee in the Debtor's 5. bankruptcy case [ECF No. 4].
- Prior to the Debtor filing bankruptcy, the principal of the Debtor vacated the leased 6. premises located at 4875 Nevso Drive, Las Vegas, Nevada (the "Property).
- When the principals of the Debtor vacated the Property, personal property was left 7. behind including files, documents and computers belonging to the Debtor (the "Personal Property") remaining in or on the Property.
- There are thousands of files and documents and many computers containing 8. confidential information.
- It is now necessary for me to employ Assured Document Destruction, Inc. 9. ("Assured") to destroy the files, documents and computer hard drives containing the confidential information.
- Assured has provided me with an estimated amount of the services after inspecting 10. the Debtor's office. Assured has estimated the amount that should not exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000), depending on the amount of files that need to be destroyed and the time spent at the premises.

11. Accordingly, I request authority to employ Assured and pay it an amount not to exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) in order to ensure that the confidential information of the Debtor's former clients are protected.

12. The issuance of a court order permitting me to employ and pay Assured an amount not to exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) is appropriate under Section 105(a) because it would allow me to expediously administer the Debtor's bankruptcy estate and fulfill my obligations under Section 704(a)(2) by being "accountable for all property received" in the context of the bankruptcy case. See 11 U.S.C. § 704(a)(2).

I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the United States that the foregoing is true and correct.
