This matter came before the Court on the Application to Employ Schwartz Flansburg,

PLLC As Special Bankruptcy Counsel for Victoria L. Nelson, Chapter 7 Trustee Pursuant to 11

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U.S.C. §§ 327(a) and 328(a) and Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 2014 [ECF No. 150]<sup>1</sup> (the "Application") filed by Jacob L. Houmand, Esq. of the law firm Nelson & Houmand, P.C., general bankruptcy counsel for Victoria L. Nelson, the Chapter 7 Trustee in the above-captioned bankruptcy case. The Application was filed pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 327 and 328 and Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 2014. The Application sought authority to employ the law firm of Schwartz Flansburg, PLLC (the "Firm") as special bankruptcy counsel for the Trustee to prosecute all claims arising from the Debtor's Errors and Omissions Insurance Policy with XL Select Professional Claims. No objections were filed to the Application.

Jacob L. Houmand, Esq. appeared on behalf of the Trustee and Bryan A. Lindsey, Esq. appeared on behalf of the Firm. All other appearances were noted on the record.

In Support of Application to Employ Schwartz Flansburg, PLLC As Special Bankruptcy Counsel for Victoria L. Nelson, Chapter 7 Trustee Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 327(a) and 328(a) and Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 2014 [ECF No. 152], the Supplemental Declaration of Samuel A. Schwartz, Esq. In Support of Application to Employ Schwartz Flansburg, PLLC As Special Bankruptcy Counsel for Victoria L. Nelson, Chapter 7 Trustee Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 327(a) and 328(a) and Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 2014 [ECF No. 159], the exhibits attached thereto, and all other pleadings and papers on file herein.

It appearing to the Court that the Firm represents no interest that is adverse to the Chapter 7 Trustee, or to the Debtor's estate, in matters upon which it will be engaged as special bankruptcy counsel, and that the employment of special bankruptcy counsel is necessary and in the best interests of the Bankruptcy Estate and its creditors, and upon consideration of the pleadings and arguments of counsel, and based upon the findings of fact and conclusions of law

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Firm shall be entitled to compensation on a contingency fee basis according to the terms and conditions provided for in the Application.
