- 1. I am over the age of 18 years and I am competent to make this declaration. I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth herein, except for those facts stated on information and belief and, as to those facts, I am informed and believe them to be true. If called as a witness, I could and would testify as to the matters set forth below based upon my personal knowledge.
  - 2. I am the appointed Chapter 7 Trustee in the above-captioned bankruptcy case.

3. I make this declaration to support the Second Interim Application of Paul M
Healey & Sons CPAs, Ltd. for Allowance of Compensation for Services Rendered During the
Period From February 21, 2017 Through February 20, 2019 and For Reimbursement of
Expenses Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 330 and 331 and Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 2016
(the "Fee Application").1

- 4. On January 9, 2015 (the "<u>Petition Date</u>"), Ameri-Dream Realty, LLC (the "<u>Debtor</u>") filed a voluntary petition under Chapter 7 of the United States Bankruptcy Code [ECF No. 1]<sup>2</sup>.
